AGE	An incoming First Grade student must be 6 before October 1, 2018.
NON-REFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEE	A non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00 must accompany registration along with a copy of the child's birth & baptismal certificates (if baptized) and parents driver's license. One of the following documents proving residency is also required: a current utility bill, a current mortgage statement, rental agreement, current property tax statement, a deed, or current homeowner/renter insurance statement.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS	<p>Girls: Regulation plaid jumper (grades K-5) or plaid skirt (grades 5-8) and a white blouse, white or black polo (no logos) or ribbed bottom shirt. Black, tan, or navy uniform line slacks.</p> <p>Boys: Black, tan, or navy uniform line slacks. White dress shirt with a collar, white or black polo (no logos) or ribbed bottom shirt.</p> <p>Shorts in the same colors as slacks may be worn from April 1st through October 31st.</p> <p>The Student Handbook contains further dress code/uniform information.</p> <p>Uniforms are available at Schoolbelles, 5718 Harrison Ave. 45248, (513) 921-3417</p>
TRANSPORTATION	Buses are available to Oak Hills District students outside a 2 mile radius and Cincinnati Public District students outside a 1 mile radius of St. Dominic School. Busing is determined by each school district based on the practicality of routing.

LANGUAGE ARTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage love of reading • Associate letters with sounds and blending into words • Recognize short and long vowels • Know 220 Dolch words • Develop reading comprehension • Develop correct handwriting skills • Introduce and develop creative writing skills
MATHEMATICS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Addition and subtraction facts to 18 • Introduce concept of money, time, and measurement • Develop problem solving skills • Explore math concepts through the use of manipulatives
SOCIAL STUDIES/ SCIENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate and discuss the growth and care of plants • Explore characteristics, habitats and movements of birds • Become aware of different types of families and interaction of members • Use popular literature to enhance the above areas
