

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

The Tuition Reimbursement Program is a GREAT program that GIVES CASH BACK to every St. Dominic student in grades K-8, without costing you a penny! The Tuition Reimbursement Program's goal is to lower the cost of tuition through a tuition credit. The credit amount is determined by receiving rebates from retailers based on money spent while shopping. Participating programs are: Kroger Community Rewards, Remke Market's Caring Neighbors Program, GFS (Gordon food service) Fun Funds, Shoparoo, and Target's Take Charge of Education Program.

Over the past 5 years, school families have received an average tuition credit of \$75 per student. We are hoping to get more families involved in this program so that the amount of the tuition credit will increase. This program is an easy way to donate money to the school, without doing anything more than your normal shopping.
